

Request for Exception to the GPA Requirement

A cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 for your Bachelor's Degree is the listed admission requirement. However, there are many ways we evaluate candidates and encourage you to apply even if you don't meet this requirement outright. Alternatives to this requirement include:

- A GPA of 3.05 in the last 60 semester (or 90 quarter) units of your undergraduate degree.
- A GPA of 3.0 or higher in at least 9 semester units of graduate school coursework.
- Or, Completion of this form and supply accompanying statement (instructions below).
