A. SUBMISSION PREPARATION CHECKLIST

Please comply with stipulations 1-8 in order to expedite the process. Manuscripts not complying with specified stipulations will be returned to their authors for reformatting.

- 1. ____ Manuscript submitted as U.S. Letter (8.5 by 11 inches) in a Word file
- 2. ____Manuscript submitted using Garamond font. If unavailable, Times New Roman
 - 1. 14 points for title
 - 2. 12 points for rest of paper
 - 3. 10 points for references and footnotes (please avoid them if at all possible)
- 3. ____ Manuscript formatted 1.5 inches top, bottom, left, and right
- 4. ____Manuscript submitted entirely single-spaced, justified, and without page breaks
- 5. <u>Manuscript length between 3,000 and 3,500 words, including title, abstract, and references.</u>
- 6. <u>Manuscript includes both a 100-word abstract and 4-6 keywords in the language of the manuscript.</u>
- Manuscript complies with American Psychological Association (APA)
