

11TH GRADE CHECKLIST AND SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

- Update your High School Course Planner with the courses you complete in the 10th grade and those you are enrolled in the 11th grade. Take advance math and English courses.

- Meet with your UB Advisor five times each semester to make sure you are on track and taking the college preparatory classes needed for post-secondary acceptance.

- Attend College and University Night programs and meet with college center counselor to get dates when admission representatives visit your high school.

- Maintain high marks in all classes preferably A and B grades. This is especially important during the junior year as this is the last opportunity to boost your GPA.

- If taking Advanced Placement subjects, register to take the AP exams in the spring. Scoring well may give you credit for college-level courses! AP exams are in May.

- Continue extracurricular activities, sports and volunteer work. Colleges are looking for longevity.

- Work on meeting your academic goals set on your Personal Educational Plans. UB expectation is to have all students maintain a A-G weighted GPA of a 3.0 throughout the academic year.

- Begin preparing for college entrance exams (SAT or ACT). UB students should take the May or June test. (We should encourage June since our students typically take AP exams in May...) Register at www.collegeboard.org for the SAT and www.act.org for the ACT.

- Upward Bound Northern California College Tours (Northern California Trip will always be held during LAUSD Spring Break) Eligible students will be notified at the January Saturday Academy.
